Poster Presentation Guidelines

- Maximum poster size is 48x36 inches. Display boards of 48x36 inches will be available.
- Posters should be printed using appropriate means.
- Titles should be at least 2 inches high. Use appropriate font styles.
- Words should be large enough to read from several feet away, but do not use all caps. The body type font should be at least 18 point, if possible.
- Text, figures, and headings should be tastefully arranged. White space should be used appropriately.
- Easels and board will be provided, and students will be assigned to a specific easel.

Set up begins at 9:30 AM and Judging begins at 10:30 AM. Lunch and award ceremony are at 12:30 PM.
